Wow, what a fantastic year! Thank you for all the incredible hard work and your generosity in 2011. Your efforts through the Miracle Home Program and other events such as the Miracle Makers Barry Gordon Memorial Golf Tournament and the "Texas Hold Em" tournament helped raise more than \$161,000. I am very proud to say we achieved the goal of purchasing a DEXA Scanner for the Manitoba Institute of Child Health as well as developing the DEXA Scanner room at the Research Institute. Your support means more than 220 pediatric researchers and technical staff will have access to the DEXA Scanner, a much-needed piece of equipment which measures the bone density in children.

RE/MAX has been a national supporter of the Children's Miracle Network and the Children's Hospital Foundation since 1992. Since that time they have donated more than \$1.5 million in support of equipment and programs at Children's Hospital and research at our Manitoba Institute of Child Health. Over the years, RE/MAX has helped purchase EEG equipment for the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit as well as incubators and other equipment for Pediatric Respiriology and the Emergency Department of the Children's Hospital.
